Application and Decision Dates for Admission to 2021/22

The following are the dates applicable for admission to Junior Infants:

The school will commence accepting applications for admission on	02/10/2020
The school shall cease accepting applications for admission on	13/11/2020
The date by which applicants will be notified of the decision on their application is	04/12/2020
The period within which applicants must confirm acceptance of an offer of admission is	18/12/2020

The school shall cease accepting applications for admission to our ASD special classes on	15/02/2021
The date by which applicants will be notified of the decision on their application for admission to the special class is	By end of March 2021
The period within which applicants must confirm acceptance of an offer of admission is	Within 7 school days of the letter of offer being issued by the school

Failure to accept an offer within the prescribed period above may result in the offer being withdrawn

Number of places being made available in 2021/22

The number of places being made available in Junior Infants is	22
The number of places being made available in the special class* catering for children with ASD with complex needs is	Maximum 6. No. of available places depends on there being a vacancy in any given year.
As an urban DEIS Band 1 school our pupil teacher ratios are as follows:	Junior Infants to 2nd Classes: 22:1 3 rd to 6 th Classes: 22:1
As an urban DEIS Band 1 school we are permitted by the Department of Education & Skills to have 20 pupils in classes between Junior Infants and 2 nd Class (Junior Classes). In the event that a Junior class has 20 pupils, classes from 3 rd to 6 th may then have up to 24 pupils. For example in the year 2025/26 if a Junior Infants class has 20 pupils, this would allow say a 4 th Class to have 24 pupils. Therefore the overall pupil teacher ratio is 22:1. The school is deemed to be full if that ratio is applicable across all classes in the school.
