The number of places being made available in the special class* catering for children with ASD with complex needs is	Maximum 6. No. of available places depends on there being a vacancy in any given year.
As an urban DEIS Band 1 school our pupil teacher ratios are as follows:	Junior Infants to 2nd Classes: 21:1 3 rd to 6 th Classes: 21:1
As an urban DEIS Band 1 school we are permitted by the Department of Education & Skills to have 19 pupils in classes between Junior Infants and 2 nd Class (Junior Classes). In the event that a Junior class has 19 pupils, classes from 3 rd to 6 th may then have up to 23 pupils. For example, in the year 2025/26 if a Junior Infants class has 19 pupils, this would allow say a 4 th Class to have 23 pupils. Therefore, the overall pupil teacher ratio is 21:1. The school is deemed to be full if that ratio is applicable across all classes in the school.
